POSITION OVERVIEW:

Working closely with the Knowledge Broker, the Knowledge Mobilization Associate (KM Associate) will provide knowledge mobilization (KM) support to Arthritis Research Canada leadership, scientists, and the Arthritis Patient Advisory Board. Specifically, the KM Associate will work with the Arthritis Research Canada scientists and staff, to develop key messages and knowledge products for target audiences regarding Arthritis Research Canada-related research, including text and/or graphics in electronic formats for social media. The focus will be on conveying scientifically accurate messaging that is concise, compelling and guided by knowledge translation/dissemination/implementation science. We are seeking someone who is passionate about research and knowledge translation, has exceptional written and graphic skills, has an eye for detail and is a creative thinker. This is a one year position with opportunity for renewal.

- Developing other knowledge products as appropriate
- Contributing to development of KT-relevant components of Arthritis Research Canada research including grant applications, data visualizations for manuscripts, posters, presentations etc.
- Collaborating with diverse partners and relevant stakeholders (researchers, health professionals, patients, public etc.)
- Performing other related duties as required
